## SNACKS:

The Preschool Program will provide daily snacks; white milk will be provided daily. The cost for daily snack and milk is \$40 a year.

## AGE OF ENTRANCE:

St. Mary Cathedral Preschool Program will accept students who are **three years of age on or before September 15th and are completely potty trained.** Due to State regulations, there are no exceptions to these requirements.

## Invest in your child's Future

The **Preschool Program** investment is \$800.00 per child for the 2009/10 school year. If you register before April 15, 2010, the 2009/10 tuition rate will be honored. Any registrations received after April 15, 2010 are subject to a tuition rate increase approved by the Finance Council. Included in this cost is a \$100.00 non-refundable fee due with the registration form. Preschool registration and tuition is separate from Pre-K & K-12 registration and tuition.
