What is one achievement your proud of?

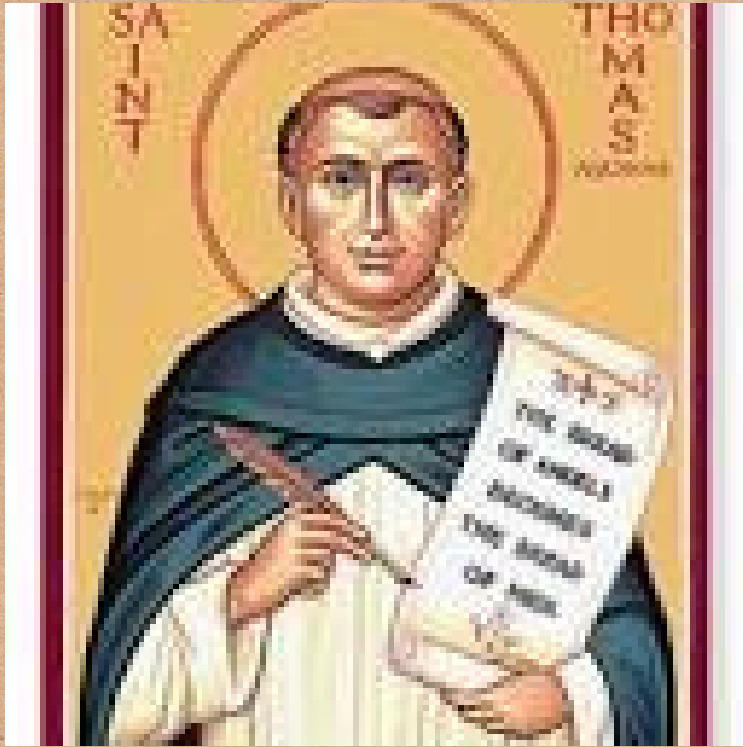

PATRON SAINT OF SCHOOL AND STUDENTS

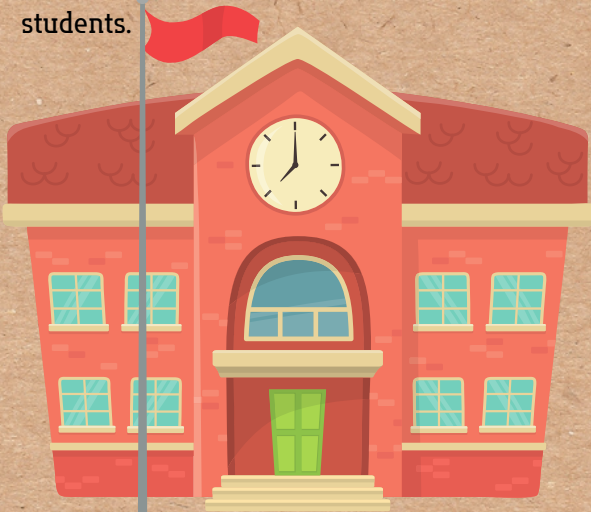
Saint Thomas Aquinas is a patron of schools, Catholic schools, and colleges/universities. He was a 13th century Dominican teacher, professor, and founder of schools. He was also declared a doctor of the Church by Pope Pius V. He taught in France as well as Italy and wrote several prayers for students.

St. Thomas Aquinas was the greatest of the scholastic philosophers. He produced a comprehensive synthesis of Christian theology and Aristotelian philosophy that influenced Roman Catholic doctrine for centuries and was adopted as the official philosophy of the church in 1917.

St. Thomas Aquinas is an ambassador for education and serves as a wonderful role model for our children.
